at Horse Creek Farm, Coldham Bank, March PE15 0BS

May 27th - 29th 2010

Summer Camp is here again! For those of you that haven't come along before we have 3 days of intensive rider training sprinkled with lots of fun stuff and trail rides. Following the 3 day camp there will be a SQH Show so you can put all the skills you have learned to the test.

People are grouped according to ability by the trainers and everyone gets to work with all the trainers. This year, up to now, we have David and Sarah Deptford and Megan Roughley. These trainers are insured and qualified and participants should ensure that they have the appropriate insurance for themselves and their mounts.

You will be riding for a good part of the day but if at any time you feel tired, thirsty etc you may leave the group and rejoin when you are ready. There will be a daily trail ride (weather permitting) and evening activities. Groups will be no larger than 6. Breakfast and Dinner is included in the price and lunch will be available in the cafe or you are free to make your own in your lorry/trailer. Tea and coffee is available throughout the day. If you wish to bring a non riding guest along they are welcome to take part in the non ridden segments of the camp and meals will also be included for them. Any dietary requirements need to be notified before the camp so they can be catered for. By popular demand we will once again have the Line Dance party on the Friday evening. Due to the later date of the Bank Holiday the camp has fallen during a school week so we are not planning a children's group.

The venue has showers and wash facilities along with horse washracks which you are free to use. Water taps are near the stable blocks. Straw is provided free of charge for bedding and the stables must be cleared out after the event. You may purchase polybagged bedding from HCF (or bring your own) and if you prefer this your stable bed can be left in but must be mucked out properly. There is a £15 surcharge for a stable left dirty.

Please use one booking slip per rider. The cost of the camp including all meals, activities and use of facilities and all training is £250. Stables are £60 each for the duration of the camp and for the show on the Sunday.

You may arrive any time after 3pm on the eve of the camp but meals will not be available so you will need to cater for yourself that night. You may use the outdoor arena only on that evening.

A deposit of £150 is required to secure your place. You may pay by card or cheque. If you pay by card the balance will be taken a couple of days before the camp (unless you make other arrangements). Otherwise please send balance cheques by May 21st.
